The Bivens Decision

See: Bivens vs. Six Unknown Agents, 403 U.S. 388 (1971)

Read Three Times:

“This meeting is private. Bearing false witness, misrepresentation, and posting inflammatory rhetoric in public forums is forbidden and shall be addressed in an appropriate manner. To eliminate all conflict and false allegations, is there anyone in attendance at today’s meeting who is a member or agent of any law enforcement agency or public agency of the federal, state, county, city or township agencies present? Is there a response to the Bivens decision for the first / second / third time?”

Follow by reading once:

“Anyone who is here under false pretenses, anyone who is working for any foreign government including the Territorial United States or Municipal United States, anyone who is being paid or coerced to be here, must fully disclose their presence and purpose now, or leave the premises or this conference call.”

If they subsequently show up as Federal Witnesses, they are discredited for failure to disclose.

Are you now or have you ever received money or “personal support” of any kind from the intelligence community?

Upon no response to this Notice of the Biven’s Decision, this meeting shall now proceed.

General Assembly Pillar

- ***The Budget Committee** – (This committee works with other committees and the banking committee ensuring compliance and oversees audits) *stasis – Will have an invoice that will need to be paid to Faith from Election Committee. General Assembly will need to handle this since it is in Stasis.*
- **The Education Committee** – (produces educational materials and programs for the General membership and Public.) **Chair- Alex©, Secretary Kerry©**
- **The Elections Committee** – (Handles notices and candidate publications, sets dates, promotes participation in elections, provides ballots, poll watchers, and ballot security.) **Chair Dennis© - Discuss Elections and Process** – *show calendar, Website Elections Notice – 3rd Notice goes out 11.18.2024; 4th Notice will go out 11.25.2025 ;5th Notice 12.1.2025. Faith helped get a paper that could send out a Notice and will be on a public state notice board as well and will retrieve and document for records. Those Notices are scheduled for 11.25.2025, 11.28.2025, & 12.5.2025. The Hamilton County Herald, Fee is 93.75 there is a request for treasury to refund. We all had to work through a paper trying to charge 837.00 and then added Paid by Political Party on the bottom and would not remove so it was rescinded and were refunded.*
- **Events Committee** – (Plans and executes events, live meetings, and election set-up (see General Elections and Quorum Committee below for more about elections) **Chair- Alex©, Secretary Kerry©**
- **New Member Orientation Committee** – (Provides support and educational guidance for new members to overcome prior indoctrination and fear and dependency issues) **Chair - Cynthia©, Co-Chair - Ryan©. Will need to find day of the week to start. Asking the Assembly for participation. Starting with the beginning slides and adjust as the Assembly grows.**
- **Ombudsman Committee** – (Provides conflict resolution and arbitration services) **Mike©**
- **Outreach Committee-** Provides timely responses (mainly via email) to the many inquiries that come in to the Assembly, mostly to the coordinators. Uses resources of both Education Committees. Will be funneling this over to recording secretaries. Has received – *7 people have been sent to Recorder to help become recorded.*

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- ***Oversight Committee** – Provides general oversight and a forum for complaints. Reviews complaints pertaining to the OPERATION of the committee and presents to the General Assembly – *Discussion has been brought up before about creating this basically it has been on Sundays and it seems no one joins. We had called this a steering meeting were coursed corrected and this is actually held on Sunday Afternoons if anyone would like to join. It is on the calendar.*
- ***Records Committee** – (Assists and oversees the Recording Secretaries and supports all record keeping activities.) Committee Secretaries – *Need a chairman; Kimberly Bullard has been helping people and are having people starting to respond to their requests. (flows from Out Reach)*
- **Vetting Committee** – *Requested for Time to discuss topics.* (Approves membership and reviews candidate eligibility for elected positions, including background checks and “interviews” applicable to the positions being applied for.) **Chair Vicky©, Co-Chair Diane©.**

Jural Assembly Pillar

- **Jural Assembly – Chairman Randy©** - *ALL Jural Assembly Court Docs have been converted to Tennessee. Jural Assembly is reviewing and making revisions. The meeting that was scheduled for Mock Trials has been postponed until after Elections. Reminder that Jural is meeting EVERY week.*
- ***Law Education Committee** - *in stasis* - 1. Evaluates educational opportunities to familiarize members of the Assembly about our Public Law and its administration past and present.
2. Presents Common Law education opportunities.
- ***Jury Pool Committee** – Develops pools of competent and eligible Jurors to serve on both Trial Juries and Grand Juries, administers selection of Jurors, reimbursement of expenses, and other issues related to maintaining and caring for Jurors.
- ***Litigation Committee** - Works with Tennessee Assembly members who have active litigation concerns to assist them with asserting their position with respect to the foreign courts and educating them to avoid entrapment.
- **Marshal at Arms** – State Marshal at Arms – **David ©**
- **Coroner’s Office Committee** - Takes on the oversight functions for the Coroner’s Office, investigates complaints and works with the coroner and the staff to improve their service and capabilities, recordkeeping, and end of life services. **Tim ©**
- **Court Venue Committee** - Seeks accommodations for the Courts to hold Session. Negotiates use of our public buildings. Invokes Ex Parte Milligan, 2 U.S. 71 *(this Committee has been meeting in the Jural Assembly as a whole and have reviewed and working on finishing the Ex parte’ and are in the process of creating one that will be shared with General Assembly.)*

Militia Assembly Pillar

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- **Militia Assembly – Chair - *Ryan*©**, Report on Militia Event – Report –

1. International – with respect to the 50 states /Federation of States
 2. International – with respect to the STATE OF TENNESSEE in Concurrent, Superior General Jurisdiction
 - 3 International – with respect to the neighboring States, Arkansas, Missouri, Kentucky, Virginia, North Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, and Mississippi.
 - 4 International - with respect to the 95 Counties of Tennessee in General Jurisdiction.
- ***Congressional Committee** – Vets candidates for Congressional offices in The Continental Congress.
 - ***Business Committee** – Conducts daily operations and watches over the daily functions of Tennessee State.

HOW TO GET YOURSELF HEARD

1. Tennessee Assembly Committee Overview

- **Formation:**
 - All committees are created during General Assembly meetings.
 - Every qualified participant has an equal opportunity to join.
 - If you enjoy something do NOT FEEL YOU ARE NOT QUALIFIED the Assembly will help you.
- **Who Qualifies:**
 - Must be fully published & NMO complete.
 - Must be domiciled in Tennessee for at least one year and one day.
 - Must have signed and sealed the Decorum Agreement.
- **Committee Size:**
 - Typically, around 5 members (not a fixed number).
 - May grow with the number of qualified participants attending regularly.
- **Attendance:**
 - New members may attend meetings by invitation.
 - However, they cannot nominate or vote on committee matters until qualified.
- **Recognition:**
 - This is the only Tennessee Assembly with verified provenance.
 - We operate as a **committee-based organization**.
- **Joining a Committee:**
 - Paperwork must be complete.

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- NMO classes and Knowledge Review must be finished.
- Must sign and seal the Participation Agreement (a covenant of common courtesy).

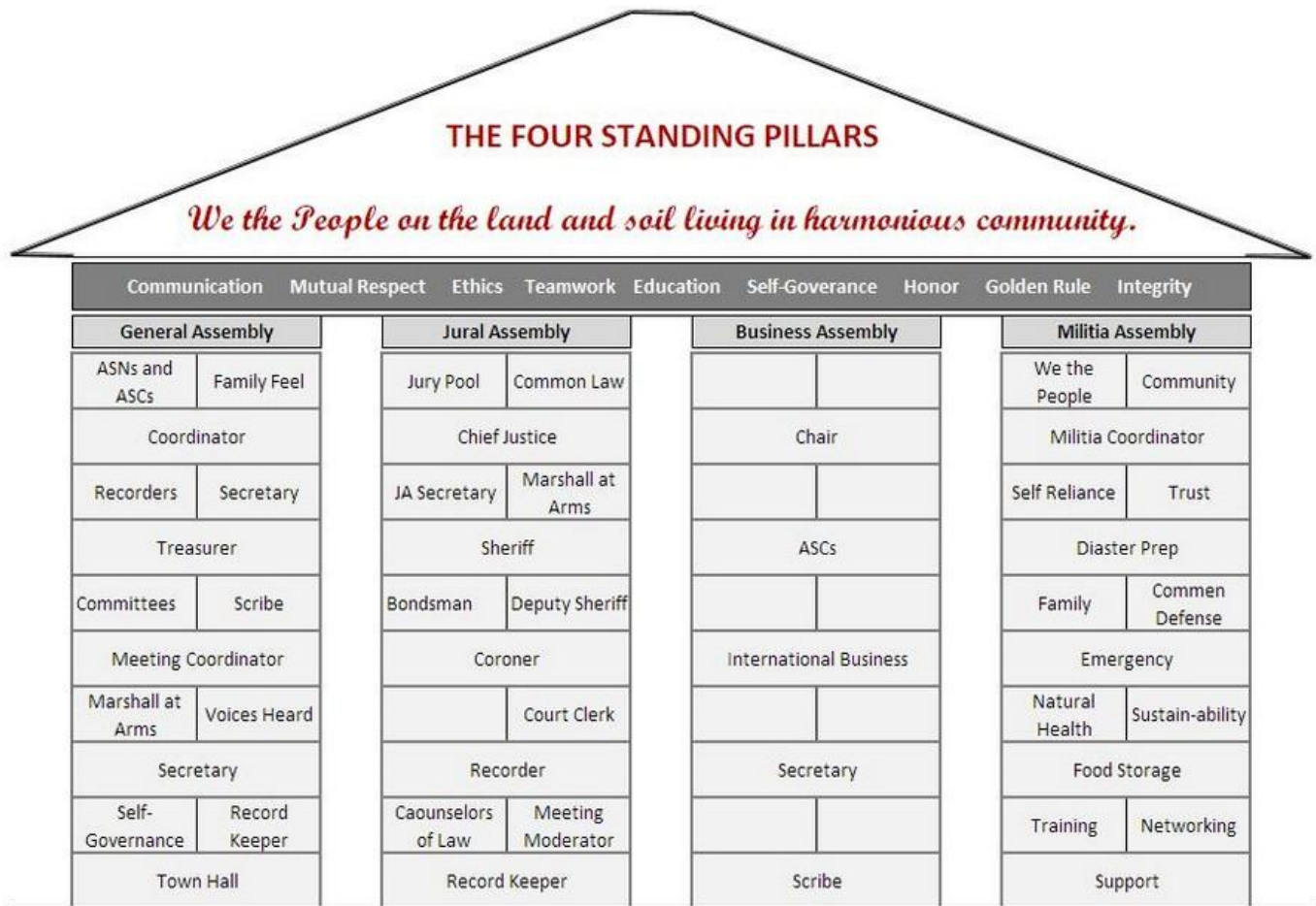
